This year, ARTrageous will be raising essential funds for a newly created Artist-Direct Grant, which will provide grants directly to artists in the GTA to cover supplies, materials, production costs for exhibitions and to pay themselves for their time and labour. These grants aim to address the lack of funding for artists, recognizing that the barriers they face in Toronto are abundant and growing.

With the soaring cost of living, shortage of studio spaces, and reduced opportunities for artists to create and showcase their work, this looming crisis poses an urgent threat to our arts community. This will have far-reaching consequences for our cultural sector and local economy. **Artists need our support more than ever.**

PIA's Artist-Direct Grant will support excellent, contemporary art projects in the GTA, and bolster artists' ability to live, work, experiment, and prosper in Toronto.

This grant will also empower artists to:

Be Innovative Create cutting-edge art works that redefine contemporary art.

Increase Exposure Showcase their work to new audiences through valuable exhibition opportunities.

Better Support Cover studio expenses, materials, and increased living costs.

Increase Visibility Leverage PIA's social media and press releases to promote and showcase their work.

Make Progress Advance their careers through audience development and educational opportunities.

Artist-Direct Grant emphasize emerging and mid-career artists, individuals from IBPOC communities, and other under-represented groups in the cultural sector.
